THERE WAS A QUESTION FROM THE FLOOR ABOUT WHAT IS HAPPENING WITH THE SALE OF THE GOLF COURSE AND CLUBHOUSE. MAYOR MARTANDALE SPOKE TO THIS ISSUE. HE SAID MERRILL WAS SEEKING TO APPLY FOR A CONSERVANCY ON HIS REMAINING LAND, BUT NEEDS INVESTORS TO MAKE THAT HAPPEN. AS OF NOW THAT HAS NOT HAPPENED.

IT WAS ANNOUNCED THAT A COMMITTEE, INVOLVED IN DETERMINING THE FEASIBILITY OF THE CITY'S PURCHASE OF THE GOLF COURSE/CLUBHOUSE, WOULD BE MAKING A RECOMMENDATION SOMETIME NEXT MONTH.
